








Main UN Road Transport Legal Instruments

Why they are important?



- Basic technical and regulatory framework
- Internationally harmonised rules and standards
- Models for developing national legislation
- Facilitate international road transport
- Legally binding + recognition of certificates
- Constantly updated, brought in line with EU regulations
- Elaborated by consensus
- Applied worldwide

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Why UN Agreements not well explored in the region



- ✓ **AETR not open** to non-UNECE countries till July 2016
- ✓ RS Agreements of 1968 **some confusion** with those of 1949
- ✓ TIR **not really applicable** in EuroMed region
- ✓ Harmonisation Convention not well known
- ✓ ADR demanding and complex
- ✓ Fruits and sea journeys longer 150 km excluded from ATP
- ✓ **VR importance** to non-car producing nations not understood
- ✓ Financial and technical implications
- ✓ Lack of capacity to accede and implement
- ✓ Country and sub-regional specificities putting obstacles
