



Roads Density


Public network coverage rate by area (Km/1000 Km2)





Roads Length per Population


Public roads network coverage rate by population (Km/100 000)







ESCWA Accumulative Knowledge in the field of Transport Priorities for Regional Integration and Globalization





















Ongoing activity: ITSAS GIS

- 5. PORTS






Roads Network Layer (Arcs and Nodes)
