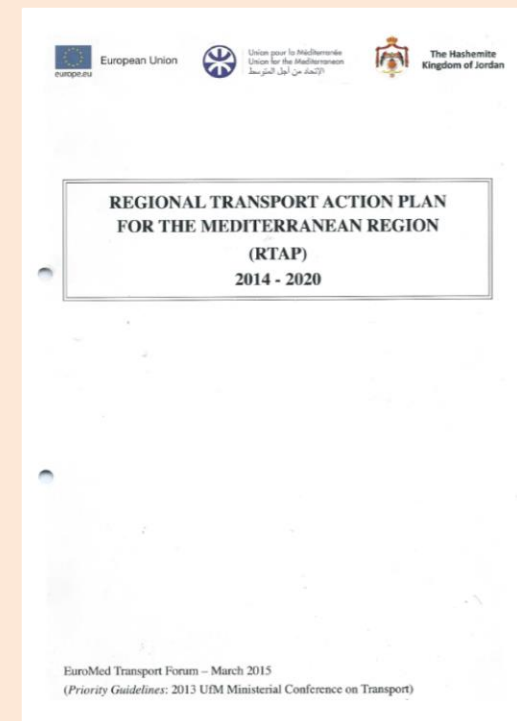
- **Two pillars:**

- Action 11: Urban transport

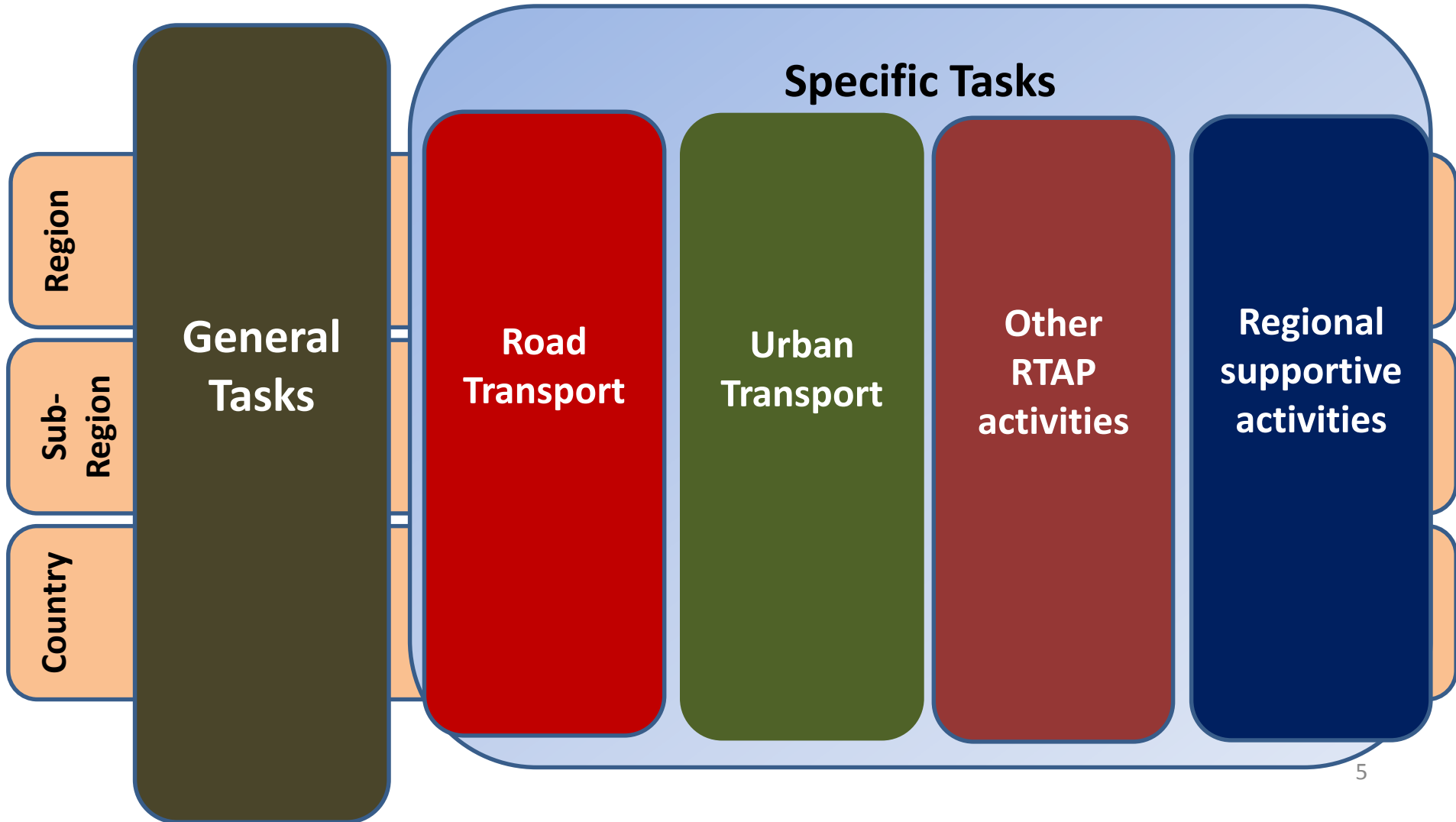




- Increase the **sustainability and performance** of transport operations in the Mediterranean region:

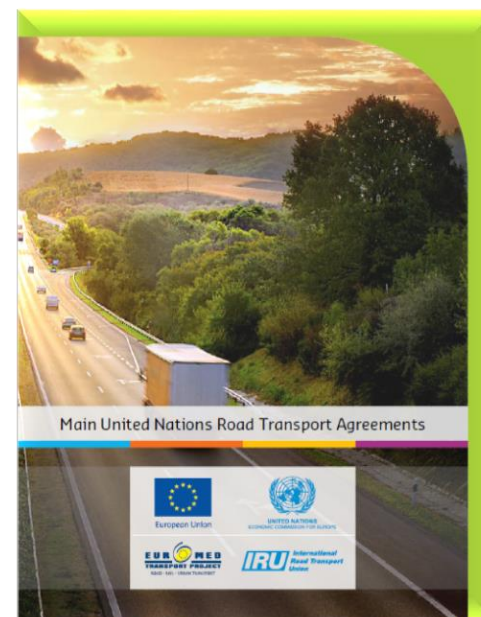
