- 1. WHAT IS A PTI SYSTEM?
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
ALL VEHICLES DEGRADE IN SERVICE. REGRETTABLY, MANY VEHICLE OWNERS DO NOT ADEQUATELY MAINTAIN THEIR VEHICLES SO SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS OF DEFECTIVE VEHICLES ARE IN USE, A MATTER OF CONCERN AS POOR VEHICLE CONDITION HAS AN ADVERSE AFFECT ON SAFETY AND THE ENVIRONMENT.

THE TARGET OF PTI IS TO ENSURE THAT THE BENEFITS ACCRUING FROM THE ORIGINAL DESIGN AND MANUFACTURE OF VEHICLES ARE RETAINED, WHERE JUSTIFIED, THROUGHOUT THE LIFE OF THOSE VEHICLES.






