- Be a **forum for discussion** on the way forward



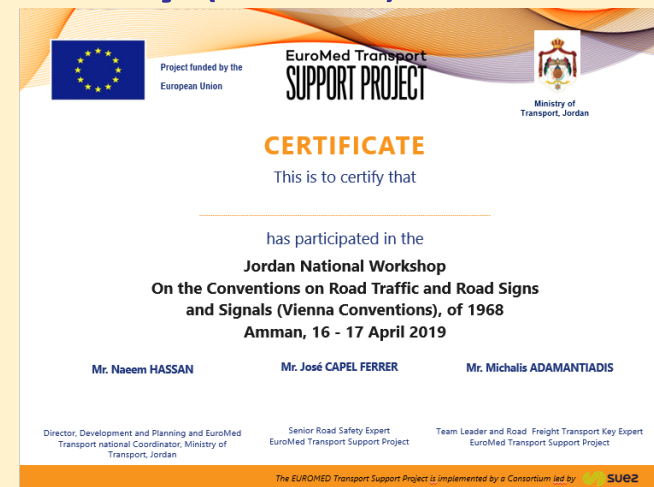
